BIOGRAPHY OF ALONZA CHARLES PLATTS

Freeman William Platts was born in Pegg's Green on the 1st December 1874. He was the son of William Cooper Platts and Sarah Nicklinson (nee. Handford) Platts. She was born in Griffydam c.1878 (parents unknown).

Freeman William Platts married Rhoda Holland, born in Griffydam on 22nd December 1877. She was the daughter of William Holland (born in Thringstone) and Louisa Haywood, who was born in Griffydam. Freeman and Rhoda were married in 1897 at Breedon on the Hill parish church in the Shardlow registration district.

In 1901 Freeman William Platts (25), a coal miner hewer, and his wife, Rhoda (23), had three children at that time - James W (3), Freeman R (2) and **Alonza Charles** (11 months) and were living on Swannington Common, Leicestershire, England, United Kingdom.

In 1911, Freeman Wm. Platts (35), a coal miner hewer, his wife Rhoda (33), five sons, James Wm. (13), Freeman Richard (12), **Alonza Charles** (10), Walter Joseph (9) and Bramley (4) and twin month-old daughters, Evangeline Norah and Louise Grace were living in a 5 room house at 55 Forest Road, Hugglescote, Leicestershire, England, United Kingdom. The couple had been married 14 years and had had eight children, seven of whom were still living.

Freeman and Rhoda also had a son, Benjamin Arthur, registered in the first quarter of 1904. He died in 1905 Q1 at 12 months of age.

Alonza Charles Platts was one of 8 siblings and the third oldest of 6 sons, born to Freeman William Platts and his wife Rhoda (see above para).

Freeman William Platts died in Leicester in 1969 at 94 years of age. Rhoda Platts died in 1958 in Coalville, Leicestershire, age 80 years and was buried on 16th October 1958 in Coalville (Hugglescote) cemetery, Leicestershire.

Alonza Charles Platts joined the Royal Leicestershire Regiment in 1918 and subsequently married Elizabeth Mary Fairs of Pirbright, Surrey in 1920 at St. Michael and All Angels Church in Pirbright. Banns were read on the 14th, 21st and 28th November 1920. They had a son Freeman Charles Platts who died on 22nd December 1934 aged 9 who was buried in Coalville (Hugglescote) cemetery.

Alonza Charles Platts registered with the 1st Battalion Leicestershire Regiment and went to India with them in 1924 at the age of 23, and was promoted to Quartermaster in 1926. He served in Egypt and again later in India, returning to England in 1931 to become Regimental Quarter Master. In 1939, Alonza's wife, Elizabeth Mary was recorded as living (presumably in married quarters with her husband) at the Infantry Training Centre, Glen Parva Barracks, Wigston, Leicestershire

Alonza served in WW II being promoted to Lieutenant in 1941. He was invalided out of service on 27.6.1942 due to poor health. He died on the 26th of April 1943 and was buried in Coalville (Hugglescote) Cemetery with his son. The burial entry gives his abode at the time as South Wigston. His wife died on the 11th of June 1985 aged 90 in Coalville, and is buried with **Alonza** and their son Freeman Charles (see page 1).
