THERE IS SOME INCONSISTENCY IN THE WAY THE INFORMATION IS PORTRAYED BUT AT LEAST WE HAVE A RECORD OF WHO WAS BURIED IN THE CHURCH YARD WHERE IT HAS BEEN POSSIBLE TO RECORD THEM. MANY GRAVES HAVE SUNK / ERODED AND ARE NOT POSSIBLE TO READ.

- There is a cross (low) above this grave to Dorothy Freason Walker. Died 11th Aug 1889 aged 64.
- There is then a small gravestone to Jane Williamson, died 1793.
- Beside this is a grave to Mabel, youngest daughter of Charles and Mary Ann Hickinbottom. Born 18th Aug 1887, died 7th Feb 1906.
- There is then a gravestone to to Eleanor Maude Mary only child of John and Mary Charvill of this parish, died 10th April 1872 aged 13 months.
- The last one in this line is to Constance, daughter of Jesse Fewkes, died 19th Oct 1880 aged 9, with Thomas Richard Shaw son of Joseph Shaw, died 1st Feb 1888 aged 27 and also, Alice wife of Joseph Shaw, died 24th June 1886 aged 27.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT RECORDED IN ANY PARTICULAR ORDER

- Anna Maria, wife of Joseph Boulton, Jnr. Of Swannington and daughter of the Rev. Mr Thomas Boulton of Brailsford in Derbyshire, died 9th Jan 1746 aged 25
- This is a broken stone against the wall to Sarah Walker, died 14th Feb 1743 aged 95.
- Also against the wall, to Thomas hope, needs digging out in order to obtain further information. This is probably related to grave No.18 in above list.
- There is a small stone in front of the wall to Durant, died 1771. Also needs digging out.
- To Mary Brooks of Coleorton, died 26th May 1879 aged 77
- This gravestone stone needs cleaning up in order to be able to read it.
- There is a small cross near / in a tree by the wall.
- This gravestone is to Elezabe Durant, died 9th Jan 1736 aged 57 (spelling of Christian name ??)
- A gravestone to Henry Whirledge, died 26th Feb 1709 and also son of Henry and Susan Whirledge, died 26th Sept 1701
- Gravestone to William, the second son of William and Jane Preston, died 20th July 1866 aged 56 and to Jane, wife of William Preston, died 28th Sept 1872
- Gravestone to Louisa Mary, wife of William Walker of Cole Orton, died 25th March 1896 aged 62, and to William Walker, died 12th Nov 1909 aged 80.
- Gravestone to Simpson, eldest son of William and Louisa Walker of Coleorton, died 24th Oct 1892 aged 34
- An overgrown grave with the stone laying down – needs to be uncovered
- A small stone in the ground reads IB 1825

- Gravestone to William Manchfield, died 24th Sept 1794 aged 48 – Could be related to No. 92 in the preceding list.
- Geaveston to Mary, daughter of John Bonser by Martha his wife, died 5th March 1785 aged 15
- Stone has fallen and needs lifting – very heavy?
- Gravestone to Hannah wife of Thomas Walker, died 28th April 1761 aged 31
- Gravestone to John Bradbury son of John and Rebecca Bradbury, died 11th June 1767 aged 31 and to Elizabeth, his wife, died 4th Feb 1760 aged 27
- Gravestone to Elizabeth, wife of John Bradbury – needs uncovering
- Gravestone to John Bradbury, died 5th July 1752 aged 51 and to Rebecca, his wife, died 26th Dec 1779 aged 85
- Gravestone – William – needs uncovering.
- Gravestone to Henry Boncer by Rebecca his wife, died 8th Aug 1752 aged 11 – This gravestone is partially under another stone and needs uncovering.
- Another stone needs uncovering
- Gravestone to John Gamble, died 6th Aug 1721.
- A small stone in the ground that needs investigation
- Grave sunk – cannot be read
- Gravestone unreadable
- Small grave – stone can't be read
- Gravestone to Thomas Price, died 11th April 1761 aged 55
- Gravestone to George Dexter, died 11th June 1755 aged 79
- Gravestone broken – name not readable, died 23rd March in their 82nd year?
- Gravestone to Richard Price, died 17th Oct 1746 aged 55
- Gravestone to William Thomas Dexter, died 12th Dec 1730 aged 84
- Gravestone to John, son of John and Mary Daves, died 28th June 1730 aged 10
- Gravestone to Elizabeth, daughter of John and Mary Daves, died 28th Jan 1751
- Gravestone to John Bailey of Coleorton, died 22nd Jan 1804 aged 72 and also Mary his wife, died 8th April 1788 aged 49 and also three daughters and one son:-
 - Mary, died May 1790 aged 25
 - Sarah, died 18th Dec 1792
 - Eliza, died 22nd Oct 1794 aged 32
 - John, died 20th March 1799 aged 71
- Gravestone to Thomas Walker (Senior), died 3rd March 1773 aged 64 and also Thomas, son of Thomas and Sarah, died 3rd November 1766 aged 24
- Gravestone to Elizabeth Walker, wife of Benjamin Walker, died 20th Oct 1744 aged 51

BURIALS OF MEMBERS OF THE BEAUMONT FAMILY AT ST. MARY'S CHURCH, COLEORTON

Physical evidence of the interment of the ancient Lords of the Manor of Coleorton, either within the Church or consecrated burial ground have been lost, with the one exception, that being of Sir Henry and Lady Elizabeth Beaumont inside the Church (depicted below). Church records may reveal the interment, in the vault under the chancel, of the ancestors and / or successors of Sir Henry, up to 1702, since when no Beaumonts were buried at Coleorton until 1827. Much damage was inflicted on the Church, its structure, and its monuments, during the Civil War by occupying Parliament forces. The reader should note that some of the following information is recorded in the appended St. Mary's old church yard burial audit and also in memorial tablets / plaques audit information, but this is unavoidable due to the complexities of the information.

In the South Chapel of the church:-



The plaque inscription reads:-

HERE LIETH THE BODIES OF SIR HENRY BEAUMONT KNIGHT, AND LADIE ELIZABETH HIS WIFE. HENRY WAS SON TO NICHOLAS BEAUMONT ESQ. ELIZABETH WAS DAUGHTER AND HEIR OF JOHN LOUIS ESQ. BY WHOM HE HAD ONLY ONE SON SIR THOMAS BEAUMONT KNIGHT, WHO MARRIED THE DAUGHTER AND HEIR OF HENRY SAPCOTT ESQ. SIR HENRY DIED THE 3RD MARCH 1607, LADIE ELIZABETH DIED THE 26TH MARCH 1608

In the Church Vault

Interred are the remains of:-

- Sir George Howland Beaumont 7th Baronet, died 7th March 1827 aged 73 years, and Dame Margaret Beaumont, his wife who died July 14th 1829 aged 73.
- Also Sir George Howland Willoughby Beaumont 8th Baronet, died June 7th 1845, and Dame Mary Anne Beaumont his wife, died Feb 15th 1835 aged 28. Also their children; Susan Mary, died Sept 25th 1827 aged one month, and Willoughby Hastings fourth and youngest son died Feb 20th 1835 aged 21/2 years.
- Also Sir George Howland Beaumont 9th Baronet, born at Lambeth Palace Sept 12th 1828, died at Coleorton June 8th 1882, and Dame Paula Menzies Beaumont, his first wife, born at Chinsurah, Bengal Dec 19th 1828, died at Coleorton on Dec 9th 1870 aged 41. Also their second son Francis Beaumont, born at Naples Feb 11th 1854, died at Hampton Wick on Jan 3rd 1875, and Eleanor Grace Caroline Beaumont, their second daughter, born at Coleorton on March 27th 1859 and died at Coleorton on Dec 16th 1870 aged 11.

The information on the latter is confusing, in that Dame Paula was buried in the church yard together with Eleanor Grace Caroline and Sir George Howland Beaumont 9th Baronet, but also listed is William Beaumont, son of Sir George Howland William Beaumont 10th Baronet, who died at Aix - les - Bains on June 21st 1914. This was Sir George Howland William Beaumont 10th Baronet's son, who was born at Eaton Square, London who was actually buried at Pere-Lachaise, Paris. It would be reasonable to assume from this that the remains of Sir George, Dame Paula and Eleanor Grace Caroline, were removed to the vault at some later stage, and William Beaumonts name was added to the grave in memoriam only.

Beaumonts buried in the old Churchyard

- In the south - east corner of the old churchyard is the grave and headstone of William Beresford Beaumont, younger brother of Sir George Howland Beaumont 9th Baronet - "In memoriam. William Beresford Beaumont M.A. Honorary Canon of Peterborough Cathedral, sometime Dean of Westa Akeley and Rector of this Parish for 36 years. He was born at Addington, Surrey on March 31st 1831. Died at Coleorton on Feb 18th 1901 aged 69 years.
- Buried in the east - side of the churchyard is Julia Beaumont, first wife of the Rector William Beresford Beaumont above. She died Sept 14th 1866 aged 30 years.
- On the right side of the churchyard path lies Elizabeth Mary Beaumont, second wife of the Rector William Beresford Beaumont. She was born at Siddlesmere, Suffolk on Sep 25th 1831 and died at Coleorton on April 5th 1900 aged 68 years.
- On the right side of the churchyard path lies Dame Lillie Ellen Beaumont's grave. She was the wife of Sir George Howland William Beaumont 10th Baronet who died Aug 18th 1946 aged 87 years.
- At the east side of the Church lies the original grave of Dame Paula Menzies Beaumont, Eleanor Grace Caroline Beaumont and Sir George Howland Beaumont 9th Baronet. William Beaumont was added to this in memoriam only, as he died in France and was buried in Paris. **Please see the information given under the heading "In the Church Vault".**

The inscription on her tombstone reads:

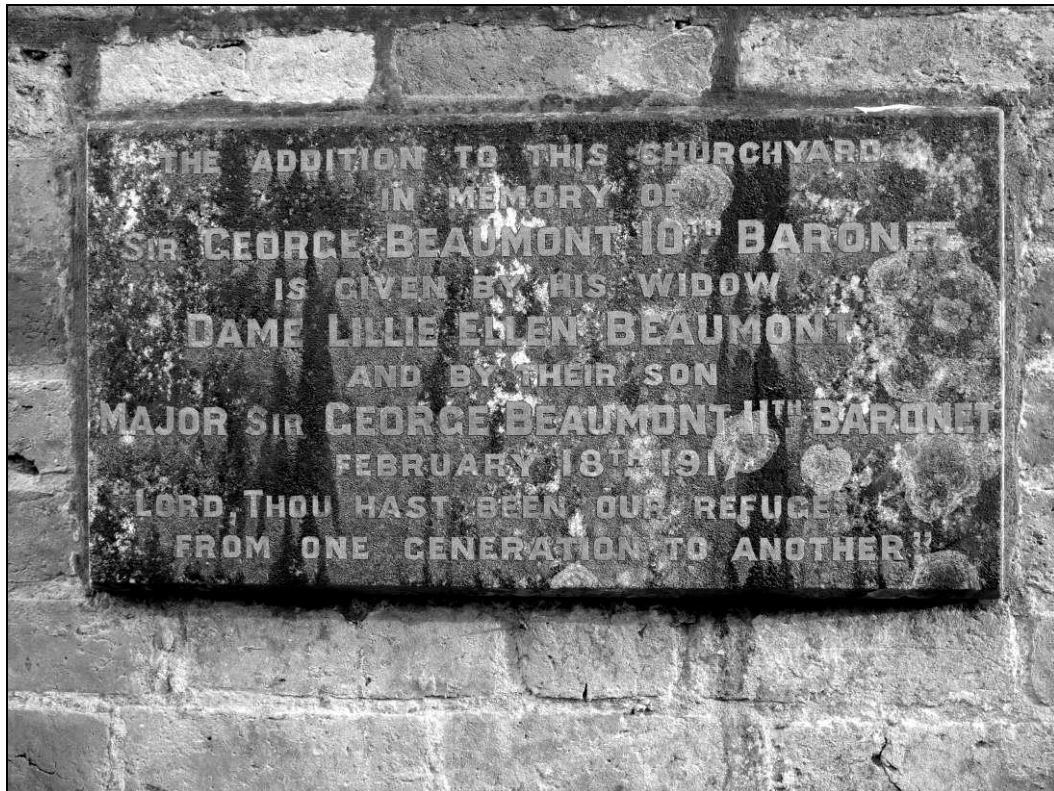

The above tree and plaque to the memory of Eleanor Brienne Collins (nee., Beaumont) was thought to have been placed at the front of the hall sometime in the early 1980's, by her brother Sir George Howland Francis Beaumont, the 12th Baronet as a memorial to his sister, and combined his mother's commemoration of her only daughter. Eleanor was the only daughter of the 11th Baronet and his wife Renee, and it is interesting that her father's nickname "Sammy", given to him by his mother, appears on the plaque. Eleanor had a dog named Sammy also.



The above photograph taken c.1930, in front of the sundial at Coleorton Hall, is of George Howland Francis Beaumont (RH side), and his younger sister Eleanor Brienne. They were the children of the Sir George Arthur Hamilton Beaumont, 11th Baronet and his wife Lady Renee Muriel.

**Grantham Journal - Oct 7th Oct 1933
Death of a Leicestershire sportsman.**

Sir George Beaumont of Coleorton Hall, died on Monday October 2nd 1933, at Lambourne, Berkshire, where he and Lady Beaumont were holiday guests at Stork House, the residence of Capt. Oswald Marmaduke Dalby Bell the race-horse trainer. Sir George, who was 52, was a well known sporting baronet. He leaves his wife, a son, George Howland Francis Beaumont, aged 9, and a daughter, Eleanor Brienne, 6. Early this year, Sir George, a descendant of one of the oldest families in the land, surprised the inhabitants of the villages near his home by calling from door to door selling garden produce.

Supplementary information – *Sir George died of Cardiac Failure & Coronary Thrombosis.*

**The Funeral of Sir George Beaumont, Bart.
October 5th 1933**

The funeral of Sir George Beaumont, Bt., of Coleorton Hall, Leicestershire, took place on Thursday. The church was crowded for the funeral which was conducted by the Rev. H. D. Handford (vicar of Ashby), the Rev. Harold Robinson, vicar of Plumtree, Notts, formerly Rector of Coleorton, and the present rector, The Rev. H. E. Stevens.

Buglers of the Kings Royal Rifle Corps, Sir George's old regiment, sounded the "Last Post" and "Reveille" at the graveside.

The mourners were – Lady Beaumont, Major-General Sir Edward and Lady Northey, Miss. Northey, Mr. Edward Northey, Mr. Rudolph Northey, Mrs. Compton Smith, Mr. and Mrs. Le Briero, Captain Bell, Colonel Heygate, Mrs. Fisher, Sir Francis Newton, Colonel Crosby, Colonel Denison (*best man at Sir George's wedding*), Colonel Sturgess, Mrs. Orfla Fisher, Mrs. Compton Smith, Colonel A.E. Martin.

Those listed as being present are far too numerous to record.

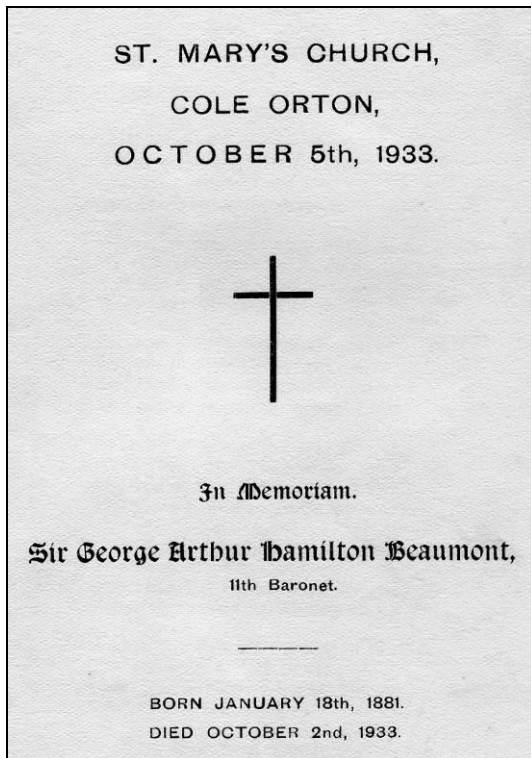
Lady Beaumont's wreath, a huge Maltese cross in pink carnations and ferns, bore the inscription, "With all our dearest love, Renee, Francis and Brienne".

The Dowager Lady Beaumont's wreath was inscribed, "In ever loving memory, from mother".

There were so many other wreaths, again far too numerous to record.

Many of the villagers and their children carried sprays of flowers, which they affectionately dropped at the graveside.

Sir George's coffin was draped with the Union Jack and he was buried in the shadow of the Hall, in the new portion of the churchyard, formerly part of the hall grounds, which he and his mother, the Lady Dowager Beaumont, of Swannington, gave to the church. A portion of this was reserved as the burial place for the Beaumont family, as the vault in the church had been closed ever since Sir George Howland Beaumont restored the church in the 1870's. (for further details, see "A History of Coleorton and the Locality" by Samuel T Stewart). The choir led the procession to the grave. The hymns sung during the service were "The King of Love" and "Rock of Ages".

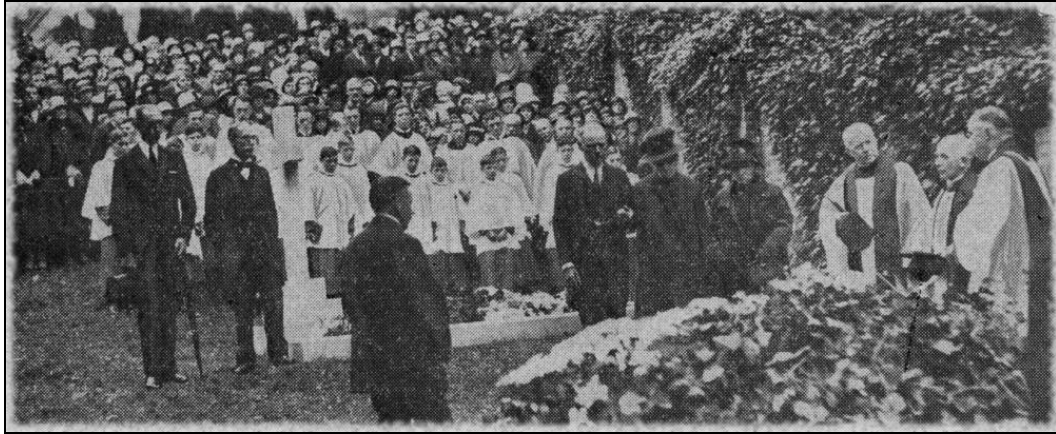
